OUT OF SCHOOL CARE AT ANNANDALE

Is about being active, being creative and having fun with friends - in a safe and supportive environment.

Our trained carers are dedicated to providing interesting and stimulating programs for all age groups.



DAILY PROGRAM

Before school, children have breakfast, and can then engage in free play, complete homework or project work, or join in with an organised craft activity, before proceeding to school at 9am.

After school, children enjoy a nutritious snack and a drink.

On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday there are activity programs organised by sports professionals.

Children can also choose from organised indoor and outdoor activities, or they can join their friends in unstructured play.

Typical activities include:

- Cooking club
- Craft and art projects, such as collage, clay modelling, sewing, painting, paper craft
- Table soccer and table hockey, board games and other indoor games
- Water play, tee-ball, skipping, volleyball, and other outdoor games and sports
- Regular events such as discos, cultural themes, “café” days and celebrations

There is plenty of opportunity for unstructured play. Supervision is provided for children who wish to work on school homework.

SPECIAL CARE FOR PRE-SCHOOLERS AND KINDERGARTEN CHILDREN

AASC takes special care of its younger members. All Pre-school and kindergarten children are escorted to their room in the morning, or met at their classroom at 3pm and escorted to the Centre.

A staff member is assigned to provide special care for younger children, and age-appropriate activities are available for them.

QUALITY CARE

All AASCC staff have undergone a Working With Children Check, and we always have a staff member on duty with a current Senior First Aid Certificate.

CENTRE HOURS

In 2008, Annandale After School Care Centre will be open on school days:

Before school: 7.30 – 9.00am

After school: 3.00 – 6.00pm

FEES

Permanent bookings (full-time or part-time):
\$10.50 per day (before), \$15 per day (after school)

Casual bookings: \$12.50 (before) \$17 (after)

Centrelink Childcare rebate is available for most families.
